

Substance Abuse Recovery Program (Fresh Start) Director

The Good Shepherd Center, a Saint John of God ministry is a mission of service to the poor and homeless people of the Albuquerque metropolitan area, is seeking a Substance Abuse Recovery (Fresh Start) Program Director to provide overall direction of the Fresh Start Program, to include direction of Program staff. The Director provides assessment, substance abuse counseling, and individual/group sessions, applying the Matrix Model Treatment Plan. Collaborates with Probation Department personnel, Court system, and other authorities as needed to ensure a safe and secure environment for recovery of the person.

Duties and Qualification Requirements:

- Certified as a Substance Abuse Counselor (LCSW or LPCC) through an accredited body of education.
- If recovering, five (5) years' continuous sobriety.
- Experience working with individuals suffering with addictions to alcohol and drugs, and/or mental health issues, using the Matrix Model Treatment Plan.
- Knowledge of the 12 Steps of AA/NA in order to journey with the person in recovery.
- Certification in CPR and First Aid.
- Ability to direct the work of Fresh Start Program staff.
- Ability to give directions to program participants working their recovery.
- Ability to design and implement a course of study for the recovery program.
- Excellent verbal, written, and interpersonal communication skills to maintain teamwork with the ability to communicate effectively with individuals from diverse backgrounds.
